

2b Mind reader!

Make sure pupils remember the meaning of the verbs in 2a. Write the verbs on the board and write the symbols next to them:

multiply X

subtract -

divide ÷

```
add +
```

Tell pupils that you are going to give them some instructions, and then you will read their minds. Explain the word 'digit', then give the instructions orally, one at a time, pointing to the symbols if necessary. Pupils do the activity step by step.

3 Something beginning with...

Ask a volunteer to say the alphabet silently. At some point, ask her/him to stop and tell you what letter she/he is up to. Write the letter on the board and tell pupils they have two minutes to fill in the categories with words beginning with that letter. You can either write the categories on the board or give pupils the photocopied sheet. You may like to add other categories such as: jobs, sports, furniture, musical instruments, adjectives. They can do their calculations on a piece of paper or on their photocopy.

Instructions:

- 1 Think of a number from 1 to 10.
- 2 Multiply your number by 9.
- 3 Add the two digits of your total together.
- 4 Subtract 5 from your answer.

Now tell pupils that you know the number they've got: it's 4! (The answer is always 4.)

When the two minutes are up, tell pupils to stop writing. Elicit answers from pupils and write them on the board. You can continue the activity by asking another volunteer to say the alphabet.
