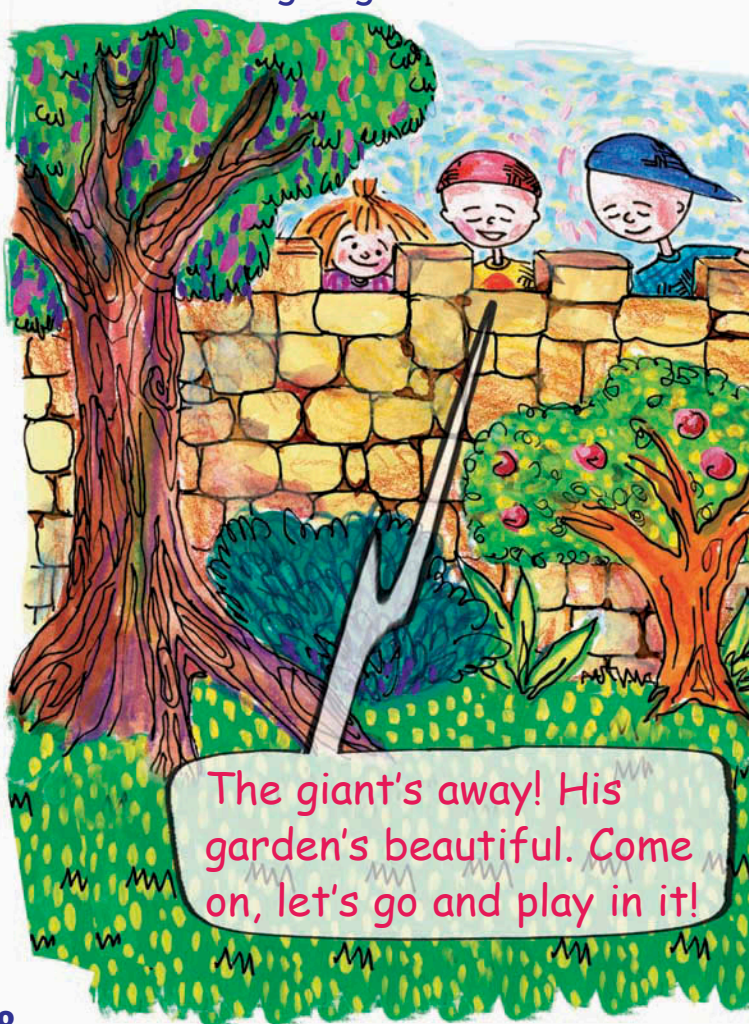


The Selfish Giant

I don't like noise!



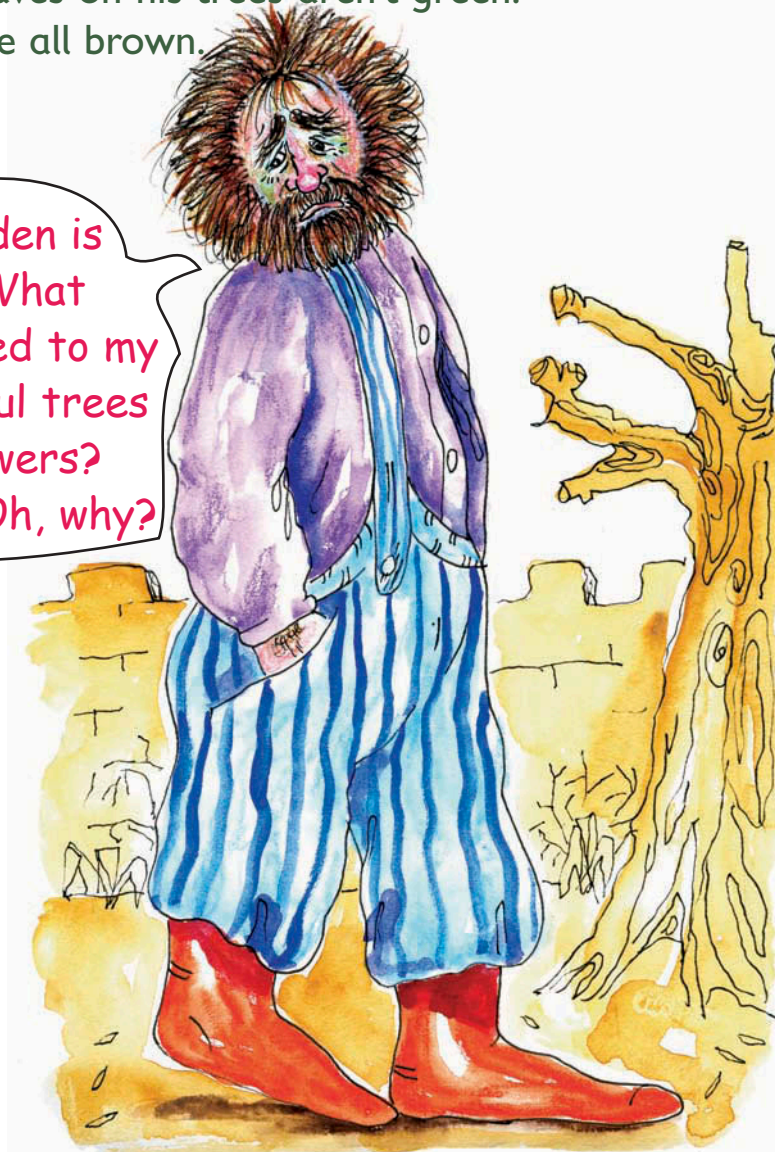
This is MY garden!

Why? Oh, why?

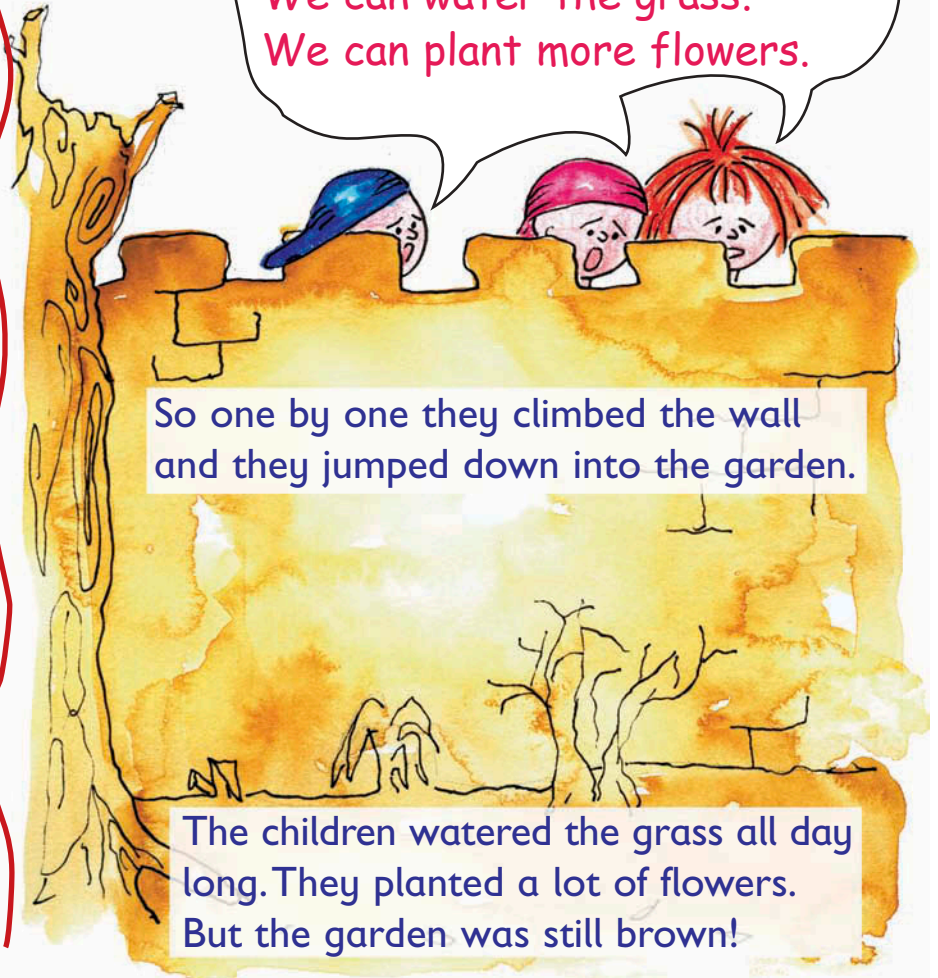


One day, the children went past the giant's garden again. They saw the brown grass and the brown leaves. They were very sad about the garden.

and they jumped down into the garden.

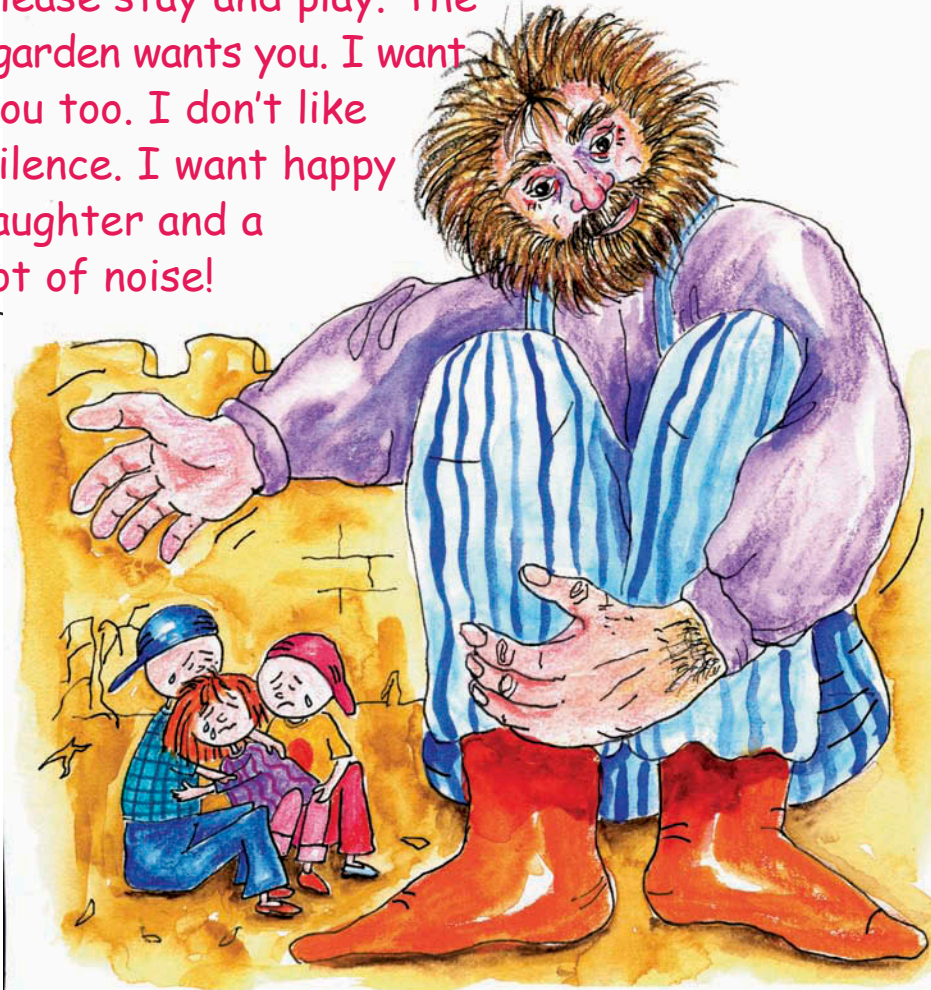
The children watered the grass all day
